Writing:

In our Read Write Inc sessions we will be looking at how to form the different letters. We will also be focussing on name writing. We will be using Drawing Club to support our writing. We will be writing about different characters, a different setting and an adventure that the characters are going on. We will be focussing on sentence structure to write our sentences.



Understanding the World: Past and Present
