## Writing:

In our writing this half term we will be using Drawing Club to extend our knowledge of how to write a sentence. We will be making new characters in the book, a new setting and a new adventure. We are still working on being able to write our names and forming the letters correctly.

## Maths:

We will be focussing on:

Week 1: Numbers from 0 - 5. Focussing on matching objects to numerals, subitising and zero.

Week 2: Focussing on numbers 0 - 5, subitising, one more and one less.

Week 3: Heavier, lighter, balancing, capacity, more and less and ordering capacity

Week 4: Find 6,7,8, Represent 6,7,8, One more, One less and composition of 6,7, 8

Week 5: Odd and even, Doubles and Combine 2 groups

Week 6: Exploring length and comparing length,



### Expressive Art and Design:

**Art:** In Art we will be exploring paint and painting techniques through nature, music and collaborative work. Developing creativity through child-led exploration of mixed-media, making collages and transient art.



**Music:** In our music this term we will be thinking about high and low songs. We will learn lots of new songs and use our bodies to move to the music. We will add musical instruments to some songs.



### PE: (Monday)

In PE this half term we are learning about ball skills. We will be looking at how to keep the ball in control, move the ball around your body, move the ball by bouncing or rolling, undertake relay races with a ball and keeping it under control to their partner.
