<u>3</u>	Minutes of Previous Meeting	Were agreed by those present at the meeting
<u>4</u>	Matters Arising	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Worship Council - have been meeting regularly and have started to make the prayer areas to go into the classrooms. Also discussed is the use of Kindness challenge of the month that the children have created on their own. <b>ACTION- AR to continue to work with Worship Council on Prayer areas</b></li> <li>• Ed discussed how he was going to speak to Governors about how they can promote their work more. <b>ACTION- Full Governing Body to address promoting governors work.</b></li> <li>• Ed needs to write to parents with questionnaire results and explain how the RE curriculum works to give parents more knowledge. <b>ACTION- Ed to write to parents regarding parent voice</b></li> <li>• Ed and Alexa to look at how parents can be more involved in worship. <b>ACTION- AT and Ed to look into how parents can be involved in worship.</b></li> <li>• Rachel discussed how she had started speaking to certain parents about a prayer group. <u>6</u>	Theological underpinning of the vision	Ed shared the theological underpinning the vision. This has been summarised by Alexa on the Summary SIAMS self - evaluation template form. This led to a discussion about SIAMS and a discussion about Year 6 discussions that have taken place in R.E. sessions regarding Sharlotte's death and why was this not stopped. Alex suggested using RE Quest that is full of resources regarding grieve and loss.
