

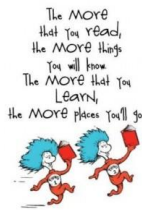

RE : EARLY YEARS AND KEY STAGE ONE BOOK CHANGE



Just a little reminder about reading in Early Years and Key Stage One. It is school policy that your child reads 5 times a week at home. This could be their reading book, a book from home or a magazine etc. We are asking parents that once your child has read, that you record this into their orange Reading Record.

To help make sure that your child is getting a new book when they have finished, each classroom has a box where your child put their book when it is ready to be changed. This will be then changed and your child will have a new book at the end of the day. We do keep an eye on the children who say they have not read at home and do not need their books changing. Also if you are wanting to keep the book longer then we recommend you write this into the reading record or perhaps not put the book back in their school bag so we know that you would like to keep the book longer.
